## **What has Dick Moore done for Bellingham?**

- He fought for \$13 million in stimulus funds for improvements to Pulaski Boulevard instead of having the same money be used to support a walking bridge at Gillette Stadium.
- He has consistently fought for 40B reforms to protect and empower communities to develop their towns as they see fit, and will support the law's repeal in November.
- He secured \$85,000 in technical assistance and emergency capital improvement funding from the Department of Housing and Community Development to replace entrance ramps at the Depot Court housing development.
- He worked with the Highway Division to secure designs for a ramp construction along I-495 on Route 126 on Hartford Ave.
- He called for the allocation of \$402,885 in Education Jobs Fund monies through the Chapter 70 formula to ensure children in Bellingham have adequate class sizes and qualified teachers.

While Dick Moore has worked tirelessly over the course of the 2009-2010 session, throughout his public service as a State Representative and as a member of the Senate, he has led the way to achieving real results on major efforts that have helped make Bellingham a beautiful place to live and work.

## **What else has Dick Moore done for Bellingham?**

- He worked with local school leaders to secure routine grant funding amount to \$22,400 for the BioTeach program, which has been in the Bellingham schools since 2007.
- He secured 10 year Drinking Water Equity Grants for the 22 water districts created in 1998, saving Bellingham \$90,467 annually.
- He landed \$800,515 in Community Development Block Grants for the rehabilitation of 18 units in Wrentham Manor.

Whether approaching issues affecting Bellingham or the Commonwealth, when Dick Moore makes a decision, he does so in a thoughtful and pragmatic way. **When fighting for anything, Dick Moore never forgets the people of Bellingham!**

- He voted against *all* major tax increases, including the proposed raises to the sales, income, and alcohol tax, and instead supported alternative means of boosting revenue through the two-day sales tax holiday.
- As the Chairman of the Health Care Financing Committee, he authored the law which will provide many of Bellingham's small businesses with the opportunity for real savings in health care costs.

Aside from working hard for each of the communities he serves, Dick Moore is a leader on a host of other matters. He has earned the trust and respect of his colleagues on Beacon Hill and throughout the country. **Dick Moore's opinion matters.**

- Besides supporting transportation, ethics, campaign finance, and pension reforms, he has authored and filed a comprehensive long-term plan to ensure that state government not only operates more efficiently but is more accountable to its residents, thus delivering more value to taxpayers.
- He helped secure \$20,000 from the Department of Environmental Protection to create the Blackstone Valley Regional Recycling Center, helping to cut back on the amount of garbage from Bellingham headed to landfills.
