- He called for the allocation of \$1,097,844 in Education Jobs Fund monies through the Chapter 70 formula to ensure children of Dudley-Charlton have adequate class sizes and qualified teachers.

While Dick Moore has worked tirelessly over the course of the 2009-2010 session, throughout his public service as a State Representative and as a member of the Senate, he has led the way to achieving real results on major efforts that have helped make Dudley a beautiful place to live and work.

- He serves on the Board of Trustees of Nichols College, and welcomed US Senator Scott Brown for his maiden commencement address this past spring.
- He has been a great friend to the Webster-Dudley Boys & Girls Club and has consistently fought for additional funding and even donated part of his cost of living adjustment in 2009.
- He secured \$2.3 million in state funding for the construction of the newly minted Pearle Crawford Public Library, a valuable resource for every resident.
