Anyone can promise that they will fight to help Uxbridge, especially when times are tough. However, as we all know, a political promise can be forgotten just as quickly as it is made.

Dick Moore has earned the reputation as a respected leader throughout the Blackstone Valley, the Commonwealth, and the nation. Time and time again, he has earned the trust of the people of Uxbridge because he has fought for their interests and achieved real results!

What has Dick Moore done for Uxbridge?

- He supported the successful efforts of the town to seek the maximum available financial assistance for the construction of a new Uxbridge High School with over \$22 million in state assistance.
- He has championed efforts to develop a bikeway/greenway through the Blackstone Valley and recently joined in announcing a \$15 million grant to jump start the planning and construction of the project.
- He led efforts to provide state disaster assistance funds to reimburse Uxbridge and area town fire departments for the devastating Bernat Mill fire in 2008, including the purchase of a new pumper for the Uxbridge Fire Department.
- He sponsored legislation honoring Uxbridge public servants by naming the Titus Ebeling Memorial Bridge and Sgt. Ben Emerick's "Road to Boston," as well as Uxbridge's historical figures—the Olympian Alice Bridges Bridge and Effingham Capron Park.
- He called for the allocation of \$428,289 in Education Jobs Fund monies through the Chapter 70 formula to ensure children in Uxbridge have adequate class sizes and qualified teachers.

While Dick Moore has worked tirelessly over the course of this legislative session, throughout his public service as a State Representative and as a member of the Senate, he has led the way to achieving real results on major efforts that have helped make Uxbridge a beautiful place to live and work.

What else has Dick Moore done for Uxbridge?

- He landed funding for the preservation and restoration of the historic Stanley Woolen Mill on Route 16.
- He convened the Uxbridge's Future Committee to encourage more civil debate on local projects. The committee also restored the facilities at Pout Pond Recreation Area and established an Uxbridge Educational Foundation that has helped to improve local education opportunities.
- He championed efforts to establish the Blackstone River and Canal Heritage State Park and the River Bend Farm Visitor's Center in Uxbridge as well as the establishment of the Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor.

Whether approaching issues affecting Uxbridge or the Commonwealth, when Dick Moore makes a decision, he does so in a thoughtful and pragmatic way. **When fighting for anything, Dick Moore never forgets the people of Uxbridge!**

- He voted against *all* major tax increases, including the proposed raises to the sales, income, and alcohol tax, and instead supported alternative means of boosting revenue through the two-day sales tax holiday.
- As the Chairman of the Health Care Financing Committee, he authored the law which will provide many of Uxbridge's small businesses with the opportunity for real savings in health care costs.

Aside from working hard for each of the communities he serves, Dick Moore is a leader on a host of other matters. He has earned the trust and respect of his colleagues on Beacon Hill and throughout the country. **Dick Moore's opinion matters.**

- Besides supporting transportation, ethics, campaign finance, and pension reforms, he has authored and filed a comprehensive long-term plan to ensure that state government not only operates more efficiently but is more accountable to its residents, thus delivering more value to taxpayers.
- He led efforts in the mid-1990's to protect South Uxbridge from being covered with asphalt and becoming a second International Airport.
- He fought to reconstruct Route 146 as a safer, four-lane, limited access highway. The fight continued to connect Route 146 to the MassPike, and recently landed federal funding to resurface the highway and make drainage improvements.
