- After the recent departure of Cranston Print Works, he called for the Commonwealth to step in and provide access to transitional assistance, job retraining and placement programs for those impacted employees.
- He secured priority funding for the intersection at Cranston Print Works, a project that was desperately needed and that once complete, will provide motorists with safe passage through a busy intersection.
- He has been a loyal friend to the Webster-Dudley Boys & Girls Club, helping to cut the ribbon at their grand opening but more importantly, consistently delivering not only state funding to support their activities, but also donating portions of his own cost of living increase to the local asset.
